RNZN Scholarship Details and Criteria

1. Purpose

- a. The Royal New Zealand Navy (RNZN) Scholarship was established in 2009 as a replacement to the Blackpool Scholarship. The purpose of the RNZN Scholarship is to support a school leaver in their first year of tertiary study.

2. Scholarship Details

- a. The Scholarship shall be known as the Royal New Zealand Navy (RNZN) Scholarship and shall be available to be awarded annually for five years, whereupon it will be reviewed.
- b. The current value of the Scholarship is \$3,000 per annum.
- c. If there is only one recipient the scholarship may be paid out in two separate amounts during the year of receipt; the first at the commencement of the course of study and the second halfway through the course of study.
- d. The award shall not be granted if any of the candidates do not meet the required standards.

3. Eligibility

- a. The award shall be made to the candidate who:
 - (1) is a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident;
 - (2) has resided in Gisborne area for at least 12 months prior to the closing date for applications; Is a fulltime student who intends to undertake full time tertiary or sports study at a Crown-registered tertiary institution or organisation in the following year;
 - (3) is formally recommended by their School Principal/Head Teacher. The recommendation should detail how the nominee fully meets the scholarship criteria listed in Paragraph 4;
 - (4) submits a CV and a written proposal of no more than 500 words outlining why they should be selected;
 - (5) describes separately the fulltime course and the Institution they wish to attend; and
 - (6) is willing to engage in publicity activities as requested by the Gisborne District Council and the Royal New Zealand Navy.

4. Scholarship Criteria

- a. The award of the scholarship shall be based on these criteria:
 - (1) The applicant's demonstration of the Navy Core Values of Commitment, Courage and Comradeship within life e.g. school, sport and in the community;
 - (2) The positive effect the opportunity for tertiary study would have on the applicant's life.
 - (3) The positive effect receiving the Scholarship would have on the applicant's life.
- b. The Scholarship may be terminated or revoked at any time on receipt of a report from the Selection Panel that the conduct or progress of the awardee has been unsatisfactory.
