The Gisborne region is prone to hill country erosion. A Sustainable Hill Country (SHC) works plan provides detail of the nature, extent and dates of planting and maintenance work planned.

A works plan should also outline any maintenance work planned for already established or planted tree plantings; such as thinning, selective or clear fell harvesting and re-planting.

This works plan is to meet the requirements of a Works Plan to treat Overlay 3A land as required under Section 6.10 of the Part Operative Combined Regional Land and District Plan (Combined Plan).

The Combined Plan requires that Overlay 3A areas of land be either treated with effective tree cover by 1 July 2011, or a Works Plan be developed and certified by the same date.
