ACTION REQUIRED

1.	Farewell Mayor – Resident thanked Mayor Foon for his long service and specific support of a goldfish farm business in Tokomaru Bay.	No action required
2.	GDC records – Request to amend incorrect records held by GDC. Records were checked and verified as being correct.	No action required
3.	Pooling Water – Water pooling by Café 35 is an ongoing issue in wet weather. Resident been waiting 200 days with no response from GDC. Previous RFS on issue 238587. T Roads have indicated that this is an NZTA matter as it is on a State Highway. Private land owner responsibility of also needs to be addressed.	RFS 249129.
4.	Pooling Water – Water pooling by Fish & Chip shop, camping ground and petrol tanks are the worst. Drainage was implemented 2 years ago, it was insufficient and subsequently removed and not replaced.	RFS.
5.	Tokomaru Bay Seawall – What’s happening with the Seawall? It’s been blessed. Started this week and work will continue into July. Fulton Hogan are the contractor. Where are you going from and where are you ending? Are you talking about just the drop outs or the whole sea Wall? There are 4 drop outs that are going to be repaired. Two diggers are on site.	RFS.
6.	Works schedule for Seawall repairs – Why do you wait until winter time to start works? Funding application, designs, consents take time. We were able to secure complete funding for sea wall repairs from central govt – no cost to rate payers. 3 years in the making.	No action required
7.	Mangahaumi River Mouth – Resident requested debris be cleared from this area.	RFS.
8.	Arthur St – 1.2m hole leaving pipes/drainage exposed causing a potential hazard. T Roads to address the issue.	RFS.
9.	Freedom Camping – Lack of signage indicating ‘No Camping’ areas. Request for signage on Waiotu Rd. Request for signage on Waiotu Rd.	RFS.
10.	Freedom Camping – Freedom campers are asking residents and illegally accessing water from Hatea-A-Rangi School, this water is restricted for school use only. Request for a tap to be installed for freedom campers to access water.	RFS.
