**ACTION REQUIRED**

1. <b>Water Tabling</b> – Resident: This needs urgent attention as it is dangerous.	RFS
2. <b>PGF</b> – Resident: How far up SH35 does that money go? Response: From the Jolly Stockman to Potaka.	No action required
3. <b>Kopuaroa Road</b> – Resident: Kopuaroa Rd to bridge has a lack of signage for trucks to slow down. There is no ‘bus’ sign and children catch the bus in this area. Also a ‘Slow Down’ sign is needed. Please address urgently for the safety of the bus and the children.	RFS 249619
4. <b>Kopuaroa Road (cont.)</b> – Resident: Did you come down that road? You should have, it needs maintenance.	RFS
5. <b>Overgrown Vegetation</b> – Resident: New toilet block in Waipiro Bay needs grass mowed around it.	RFS
6. <b>Ihungia Rd</b> – Resident: This road requires tarsealing as the dust is a major issue and hazard.	RFS
7. <b>Metalling</b> – Resident: With regards to metal laid on Kiekie Rd, does anyone check it? Cr: How much of the \$312m allocated by the PGF is for fixing the deterioration of local roads?	No action required. Referred to T Roads.
8. <b>Overhanding Vegetation</b> – Resident: The issue of a large overhanging branch has raised an RFS previously. The area is referred to as ‘Blunts’ located on Waipiro Road about a kilometre from the SH35 junction.	RFS
9. <b>Harvesting Pines</b> – Resident: Pine trees near Waipiro Bay will be harvested soon, will the roads be strengthened? This will be a problem.	No action required. Referred to T Roads.
10. <b>Kaitiaki Work</b> – Resident: There is a lot of work involved in processing RMA consents, often required at short notice.	No action required.
11. <b>Waikawa Rd</b> – Residents: Will this road be upgraded? It is a recreational area, particularly for young people. The urupa is not accessible in its present state, only by 4x4 which restricts many from attending tangihanga.	No action required. Referred to T Roads.
