## Activity 6

### How much wastewater do we make in a year?

Imagine that someone corked up the wastewater outlet in your home during the night.

Everytime you turned on a tap, flushed the toilet, had a shower or a bath the wastewater couldn't get away and your house would start to fill up!



Gisborne produces about 560 litres of wastewater everyday *per household*. Look at your school's rugby field then estimate how deep it would have to be dug to hold all the wastewater you and your family produce in a year.
