<p>ADDENDUM to S.42A Report on two publicly notified resource consent applications by Eastland Port Limited.</p>

1. I have prepared the S.42A planning report for the two applications from Eastland Port.
2. In that report I have discussed the submissions lodged by Ngati Porou and Rongowhakaata in opposition to the applications. I have also referred to the consultation and proposal by Eastland Port to work with Tangata Whenua to develop a cultural impact assessment and framework for the whole of the Port area.
3. An email from Ngati Porou Fisheries Limited (Ken Houkamau) has been received on 1 May 2018 which is on behalf of the group who presented the original submission. Mr Houkamau advises that they are comfortable with the discussions and proposal by Eastland Port to develop a tool to monitor cultural and environmental impacts (the mauri compass). They also advise that they support the artificial juvenile crayfish habitat.
4. As the planning report has been finalised and is currently under internal GDC review, this addendum has been prepared to update the planning report.
5. In my opinion, the email from Mr Houkamau will enable more confidence in the assessment of cultural values and allows the opportunity for Eastland Port and Tangata Whenua to work on the cultural impact assessment and framework outside any specific resource consent process or specific conditions.
6. The submission from Rongowhakaata also raises cultural concerns and we will need to hear from Rongowhakaata as to whether their opposition to the applications still stands.
7. My recommendation to grant consent to the applications remains the same however this update on cultural matters helps to clarify and provide some assurance on how the cultural matters and concerns can be addressed.

I haven't had time to write a letter, but I can confirm we have had conversations with Eastland Port.

Discussions with the port have been largely positive and well received by the group (Ngati Porou Seafoods Group and Others). That is the port are willing to work together to develop a cultural assessment framework for the inner harbour basin (Te Toka a Taiau) and utilise the mauri compass as a tool to monitor cultural and environmental impacts activities are having on the area. Furthermore, artificial juvenile lobster habitat being put into the new wharf structure we see as a positive.
