My full name is Isaac Hoani NGATAI.

I am the sergeant in charge of the Alcohol Harm Prevention Team for the Gisborne Policing District.

These duties include the vetting of all types of license applications through the District Licensing Agency.

The object of the monitoring process is to ensure that premises and persons applying to hold such Licenses maintain standards reflecting the criteria to continue to hold or obtain these licenses.

On the 20th November 2018, police received the Off Licence Renewal application for VDV Ventures Limited for the Red Door Liquor Kaiti, situated at 506 Wainui Rd, Gisborne.

Police submit that they have considered "Criteria for renewal" under section 131 and have no matters of concern.

The application Listed 2 managers, which is sufficient to operate the premises.

The applicant has appropriate systems, staff in place to comply with the law.

The applicant has sought for hours from 9.00am – 9.00pm, which meet the criteria of policy 3.2 relating Maximum Licensed Operating Hours for an Off licensed premise in Gisborne.

PRO On the 26th November 2018, Constable TUISANO prepared a report and **EXh 1** sent it to the Gisborne District Licensing Agency with no objection to the application. I now submit report as an exhibit pursuant to section 9 of the Evidence Act. **(Produce Exhibit 1, Police Report).**

Over the past 6 years, Police have conducted 14 controlled purchase operations at the Red Door Liquor Kaiti. They have passed on all occasions.

There is nothing of any significance to report on about the premise over the past 7 year period.

Everything in this statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief, and I made the statement knowing that it may be admitted as evidence for the purposes of a standard committal or at a committal hearing, and that I may be prosecuted for perjury if the statement is known by me to be false and is intended by me to mislead

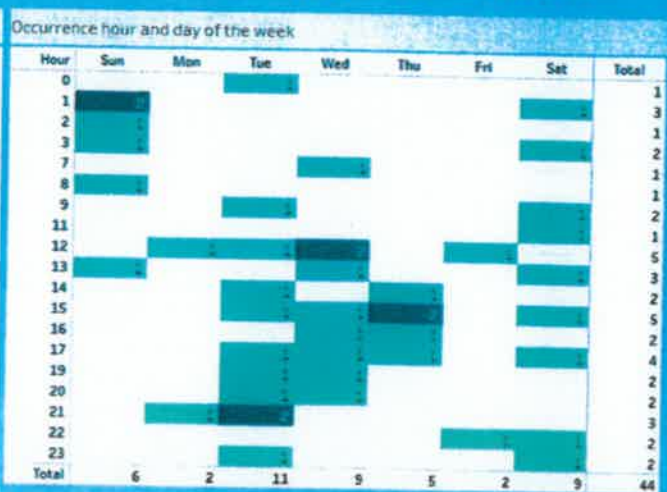
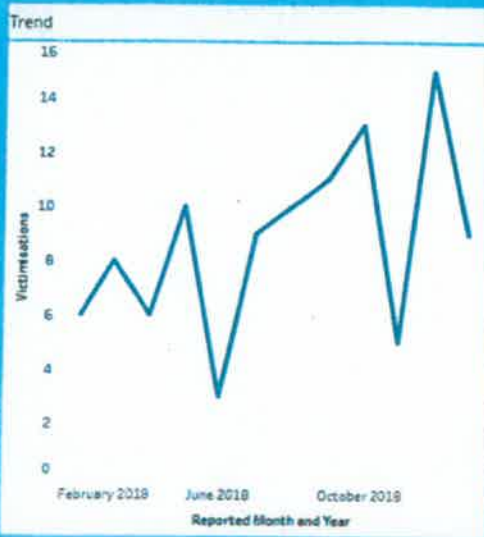
