

## Eastland Port Ltd: Wharves 6 & 7 Redevelopment

### Resource Consent Applications: List of Activities

#### Coastal Permit Application

- a) Demolition of, and alterations to, existing wharf structures;
- b) A new pile wharf structures and associated reclamations of approximately 1530m<sup>2</sup> (Wharf 6) and 4200m<sup>2</sup> (Wharf 7),
- c) The discharge of treated stormwater into the coastal marine area from an outfall in the Wharf 6 sheet pile wall approved as part of the adjacent Wharfside logyard redevelopment;
- d) Capital dredging of approximately 28,500m<sup>3</sup> of seabed adjacent to Wharf 6 to form vessel berth pockets;
- e) Maintenance dredging of approximately 1,500m<sup>3</sup> of material on average each year from the new Wharf 6 berth pockets and associated area;
- f) Disposal of the approximately 28,500m<sup>3</sup> of capital dredge spoils, along with maintenance dredgings of approximately 1,500m<sup>3</sup>/year, at the Outer Spoil Disposal Ground;
- g) Discharges of decant water from the capital dredging, maintenance dredging and dredge spoil disposal activities to coastal waters;
- h) Noise emissions from construction activities associated with redevelopment of the Wharf 6 and Wharf 7 areas; and
- i) Noise emissions from vessel loading and other activities on the redeveloped Wharf 6 and 7 areas.

#### Land Use Consent Application

- a) Earthworks involving the excavation of approximately 9,910m<sup>3</sup> of material, including some soils that possibly contain contaminants;
- b) Construction works possibly affecting a Recorded Archaeological Site and a Post European Contact Site within a Heritage Alert Overlay;
- c) Noise emissions from construction activities associated with redevelopment of the Wharf 6 and Wharf 7 areas; and
- d) Noise emissions from vessel loading and other activities on the redeveloped Wharf 6 and 7 areas.
