Environmental Concerns: I am worried about potential negative effects on local ecosystems, wildlife habitats, or coastal areas, especially given the trail's proposed location across private land, reserves, and sensitive coastal margins.

Landowner Rights: The trail's route crosses private land, and I am a landowner and have a vested interest in the land, I oppose it due to concerns about land use, access rights, and impacts on my property.

Cultural or Heritage Issues: I have concerns about the trail affecting cultural and historical sites, which are significant for our iwi.

Public Safety: If the trail passes through or near road corridors, I am concerned about safety risks for pedestrians and vehicles.

Lack of Adequate Consultation: I feel the consultation process hasn't been thorough enough, I oppose the trail due to insufficient engagement with local communities, landowners, and stakeholders.

Increased Foot Traffic: The 500km trail could bring large numbers of visitors to previously quiet areas, which might strain local infrastructure, increase waste, and lead to overcrowding.

Potential Disruption: I am concerned about the disruptions caused during the construction phase, including noise, traffic, and disruption to local wildlife and agriculture.

The reasons for making my submission are (briefly describe the reasons for your views:

I oppose the Te Ara Tipuna Trail project due to concerns about its environmental impact, including harm to local ecosystems, wildlife, and sensitive coastal areas. The trail's crossing of private land raises issues around land rights, potential disruption to agricultural activities, and inadequate consultation with affected communities and iwi. Additionally, the project may impact cultural and historical sites, pose health and safety risks to pedestrians, and cause disruptions during construction. Environmental Impact: Potential harm to local ecosystems, wildlife habitats, and coastal areas, especially in sensitive regions like private land and coastal margins.


Landowner Rights: The trail crosses private land, and I oppose it due to concerns about land use, access rights, and impacts on my property.

Introduction

- 1. My name is Charles Pipi Tukukino Royal I am of Te Whānau-a-Maruhaeremuri descent. I write on behalf of te whānau Royal and my wife Tania Royal I am a landowner at Ōrete Q, and I have been entrusted with the privilege of being one of many custodians of this whenua. This responsibility was passed to me by my mother, Kahukura-a-Maru Royal (née Callaghan), who inherited if from her parents, my grandparents Pene and Hineterā Callaghan, and the generations of Tipuna before them.
- I write today to <u>oppose</u> the application for Resource Consent (RC2024-04) and all other consents that have been applied for by the Te Ara Tipuna Charitable Trust.
- 3. In particular, I am writing to formally express my concerns regarding the proposed plans to build a walking track and erect a compostable public toilet on the land at Ōrete Q in Waihau Bay. I find this completely appalling and concerning; and my whānau and I feel compelled to voice our opposition to these plans.

Background

- 4. My whānau has lived at Ōrete Q for many generations. My grandparents Pene George and Hineterā Callaghan worked the land as young people and continued to do so until their passing many years ago. Following their deaths, my mother and her siblings (my aunties and uncles) became the custodians of the land, guided by the principles of retention, utilisation, and preservation in accordance with tikanga. Over a decade ago, this responsibility was passed down to my cousins and me, and we continue to uphold these values today.
- 5. My whānau is deeply connected to this whenua through whakapapa. For my mother, Kahukura-a-Maru and her siblings, Ōrete Q was regarded as a treasured taonga. Today, it remains a central gathering place for approximately

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two hundred uri (descendants) of Pene George and Hineterā Callaghan, a testament to their dedication to retaining ownership and preserving the integrity of the whenua.

- 6. Sadly, the privilege of retaining ancestral land is one that many no longer have. For this reason, our whānau is deeply committed to preserving our whenua safeguarding it as it was in the time of our Tipuna.
- 7. First and foremost, Te Koi o Ōrete is far more than just a piece of property; it holds deep significance for our whānau as a tangible connection to our Tipuna. It embodies the history, culture, and legacy of our ancestors, serving as a vital link to our whakapapa. Te Koi o Ōrete has been a place of sentimental significance for the whānau.

8. Te Koi o Ōrete is a taonga to our whānau, and as such, we have the inherent right to exercise our Tino Rangatiratanga over this whenua. This right is guaranteed under Te Tiriti o Waitangi. The proposed developments disregard our right and our authority to determine the future and use of our taonga and ancestral land. The construction of a walking track and public toilet directly contravenes our right to protect and preserve this taonga in accordance with tikanga Māori and Te Tiriti o Waitangi.

Cultural Value

- 9. Approximately a decade ago, a tūpāpāku (deceased body) was discovered on the whenua in the location where Te Ara Tipuna Charitable Trust proposes to erect a public compostable toilet. Archaeologists confirmed the remains were pre-colonial based on the way the tūpāpāku was buried (assuming the foetal position), a traditional practice of our Tipuna. This discovery solidifies the immense cultural and historical importance of Ōrete Q, and underscores the need for its preservation. To build a wharepaku (toilet) on this whenua is a profound desecration of our ancestral land and an affront to our tikanga.
- 10. The proposed walking track and public toilet serves no benefit to the whānau who own and are kaitiaki of Ōrete Q. The whenua is not inaccessible; it can already be reached by foot, road or by sea. Additionally, there are no residents living at the far end of the land, making the development unnecessary for access purposes.
- 11. The resource application by Te Ara Tipuna Charitable Trust suggests the walking track could serve as a secondary emergency access route or provide

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Civil Defence options during emergencies. However, these justifications do not apply to Ōrete Q due to the existing accessibility discussed in paragraph 10.

- 12. This leaves only one plausible motivation for the development; the financial benefit to tourism operators and associated industries. Such a commercial endeavour prioritises external interests over the rights, values, and wellbeing of tangata whenua and their taonga.
- 13. Our whānau has maintained a strong connection to Ōrete Q for generations, guided by tikanga and the principles of preserving the land as it was entrusted to us by our grandparents and Tipuna. The proposed developments risk damaging the integrity of this sacred site, both physically and spiritually. The construction and increased foot traffic will disrupt the natural environment and desecrate a place of immense cultural significance for our whānau.

Comment

- 14. With the ongoing challenges that Māori face from central government decisions, it is disheartening to see similar encroachments happening from within our own people. Disguised under the guise of Te Ara Tipuna Charitable Trust, this proposal encroaches on both our property rights and Treaty rights guaranteed under legislation and Te Tiriti o Waitangi.
- 15. Te Ara Tipuna's actions threaten our tino rangatiratanga as Māori landowners and undermine the protections afforded to us by our whakapapa. Such developments, which serve external interests rather than tangata whenua, must not be allowed to proceed.
- 16. Apart from a notification letter sent to Jocelyn Callaghan, Te Ara Tipuna Charitable Trust has not engaged or consulted with us on their plans to build and erect a walkway and toilet on our whenua e kore rawa!

Recommendations

- 17. Throw out the Application for Resource Consent (RC2024-04)
- 18. Build a walking track on your own whenua



We especially <u>oppose</u> Te Ara Tipuna walkway coming through our private and remote whanau settlement of Reporua. Hekia Parata and the Trust have mapped a public walkway through our peaceful and private ancestral lands, without first consulting with any of us owners. It resembles a further confiscation of our land rights, and quiet enjoyment of our turangawaewae.

Our family had no idea that the walkway was crossing our land, until whanau attended a hui On 7th March 2024 in Ruatoria, facilitated by Hekia Parata and Selwyn Parata. Hekia Parata and her brother Selwyn Parata, are 2 of 5 Trustees on the Te Ara Tipuna Trust. Their sister Apryll Parata is the Project Manager, it's definitely a family affair! Their nephews company, Parata Ltd was contracted to build the trail walkway in Ruatoria. They evidently are very self interested and have no respect at all for us landowners! Nor our mokopuna's interests and rights to our Maori land interests and to continue enjoying our whenua and quiet space.

Recently, the three Parata siblings convened a meeting a Mangahanea Marae to discuss the walkway proposal for Reporua and Tuparoa locations. They have at no point considered holding the meetings at the Marae that the walkway will pass by and most affects, including Reporua Marae at Reporua, and Umuariki Marae and Ruataupare Marae at Tuparoa (see attached maps).

My children and I, my nieces, nephews and living siblings <u>wish to be heard</u> in regard to the global resource consent being sought by Hekia Parata and her Te Ara Tipuna Trust.

The Trustees need to honor our rights as land owners and the walkway is not welcome on our turangawaewae. We see what our relations in Rotorua have to put up with having tourist encroaching on their privacy and whenua. We don't want that for our mokopuna!
