~~I oppose this group's application for consent to build the Te Ara Tipuna trail from Te Puia Springs through Waipiro Bay, towards Whareponga and then onto Ruatoria. The trial proposes to cross our volatile lands that are still recovering from the recent cyclones and our Waipiro Bay road is closed and has been for some time, limiting access for emergency services and other services needed in Waipiro Bay. We have major damage to our blocks and multiple hazards as the land is moving and continues to do so.~~

I/we seek the following recommendations or decision from the Territorial Authority (please give precise details including the general nature of any conditions sought. Use additional pages if required):

~~A community hui was held in Waipiro Bay hosted by the Te Ara Tipuna trial group to share with the locals their proposal of the trial from Gisborne to Opotiki. They shared with the whanau minimal information simply highlighting the benefits of their proposal. This hui failed to tell the whanau all of the details that included things like, if the track crosses your land we are responsible for taking care of it, which makes it liable, and imposes a reasonable burden on our people who are not in any position to maintain this track. This group also failed to inform all whanau where they intend the trail to go through. On the GDC website it shows the trial accessing the road ways, we were later informed that the trial intended to divert off the roads and impose itself on to our blocks of lands which we do not agree to or do not support. The Te Ara Tipuna trial organising committee/team/trust were they forthcoming about their proposal. They failed to answer challenging questions put to them at the hui and dismissed whanau that challenged them. It was not till after their presentation that we were made aware of potential issues, possible hardships and hazards this trial can create and also there are potential safety issues for residents. Our block has multiple hazards on it, we are not currently resourced to address the slash and land erosion issues, the non-existent fences that sees wild bulls and other animals crossing into our blocks is a huge hazard for tourists. As a trustee of this block and a solo mother that lives on this block with no other permanent whanau living close by (who rarely come home) I strongly oppose this application. I recommend that consent is not granted, and that if the GDC and Te Ara Tipuna Charitable Trust wishes for this track to continue then explore the use of dc land, i.e. using the main roads that are maintained more regularly than our local roads which are currently in poor, unsafe and closed conditions.~~
